We hope that everyone had a nice Thanksgiving Day. Care Corps was invited to be part of the "Fremont Thanksgiving Dinner" at Midland University. Midland donates their Dining Hall for the preparation of the meals and the setting for the dinner. This is quite the event with nearly 800 Thanksgiving dinners being served, and even more impressive is the additional 800 meals that are delivered to Fremont residents even before the dinner begins. This dinner would not be possible without the giving spirit of this community and over 200 volunteers to make it happen.

In much the same way, Care Corps would not be able to provide the services and shelter to the homeless without this same support. Whether it is through volunteering, donating food and clothing, or assisting financially, the community support is paramount to the success of our mission. Many people do not realize that Care Corps provided over 12,500 nights of shelter for over 450 people in the last year. Considering that 54% of our clients are families with children, and nearly 90% of them are from the Fremont area, is an indication of just how important an Emergency Shelter is to our community. For many families that we serve, this will be the first Christmas they spend away from their own home. Fortunately with our community support, Care Corps will be able to provide a safe environment for the Holidays.
